Detroit Fire Department services the Detroit, Michigan area. They have been an LE customer since 1999.

APPLICATION

The fleet consists of 48, 1999-2002 EMS ambulances. These units are equipped with Ford F350 7.3 liter engines and E40D transmissions. They also have 40 pumpers made by 5 different manufacturers, 24 hook ladder trucks, and assorted other vehicles.
